## Tasmanian Cold Chain Breach Management Flow Chart

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Twice daily: check and document vaccine refrigerator temperature



assessment form and return it

to the Immunisation team

If temperature has dropped below +2°C OR has exceeded +8°C

1. Isolate all 2. Mark as "DO 3. Do not discard impacted vaccines NOT USE" vaccines Keep impacted vaccines in a monitored vaccine refrigerator between +2°C to +8°C, noting these may need to be moved into an alternative vaccine fridge if temperatures cannot be maintained between +2°C to +8°C.
